### **General description**

### **Elective Courses (select courses to total at least 6 semester hours)**

A student with a minor in French will complete at least fourteen credit hours consisting of two courses at the 2000-level and two at the 3000-level or higher; none, however, may also be used to satisfy the requirements for a student's major. A student may opt to test out of the intermediate level courses by taking a written proficiency test in the coordinator's office. Students must pass all coursework with at least a C.
